RV PARKING/CAMPING

RV PARKING GUIDELINES

For RV parking starting June 4th thru 9, 2012 you need to use the reservation form provided here or in the National Specialty Premium List.

There are 76 RV parking spaces located behind the Purina Event Center, with 50 amp hookups, water & sewer. The fee for parking is \$25.00 per night. Reservations may be made on the form provided here or the form in the premium list. An additional 48 parking spaces are available in the overflow RV lot located on the gravel lots above the outdoor show site and rings. Fee for the overflow lot is \$10.00 per night. All RVs will be REQUIRED to show a permit to park issued by the SCOA for the above dates. Anyone not displaying required permit will be removed from the show site. THERE WILL BE NO RV PARKING ON ANY BLACKTOP PARKING LOTS. The Mississippi Valley/Rhineland KC Parking Committee will be in charge of all parking for the 4 all-breed shows Thursday May 31 thru Monday June 4 at 12pm.

The **Wildwood Hotel** is to be the host hotel for the 2012 SCOA National Specialty. A special rate of \$79.00 per night (plus 15.68% tax) has been negotiated by Pres. Jay Kappmeier. The rooms are in the name of The Saluki Club of America and are booked from June 3 through June 11. Only a limited number of rooms are available, so we recommend you book early.

There will be a \$50.00 REFUNDABLE dog fee. The fee will be returned, or not charged to your card once they inspect the rooms. They will have extra staff on hand Saturday morning (best of breed day) to expedite the inspections. The hotel is relatively new and the rooms are very nice.

Included in the hotel room price are:

*Continental Breakfast
Wireless Internet Access
Underground parking
Fitness room
An indoor pool with a spa*

32" LCD TVs, hairdryer, coffee maker, iron and ironing board are available in each room.

The Saluki Club of America and its attendees agree to use designated walk areas for all dogs. Pick-up and removal of waste is the responsibility of the owner. SCOA will put baggies in designated walking areas and ask that people are diligent in cleaning up after their dogs.

Dog kennels (crates) in sleeping rooms are required to have plastic liners under the dog kennel. When guest is away from sleeping room, all dogs are required to be in kennels in order for Wildwood Hotel Staff to service sleeping rooms.

A maximum number of four (4) dogs are permitted in each guestroom
